- Provides the process in a culturally responsive manner

  - Encourage participation



# N.C. High Fidelity Wraparound Frequently Used Terms

Feature	Explanation
<b><i>Collaborative Approach</i></b>	Coordination of various systems, natural supports, and community supports to promote health, safety and well-being of the youth and family.
<b>Consent to Participate</b>	A signed agreement to voluntarily be involved in a support or service.
<b><i>Family Support Partner (FSP)</i></b>	A parent/caregiver with lived experience in parenting child/youth who has received services. The FSP understands the challenges of navigating a complicated service delivery system (e.g. DSS, Juvenile Justice, schools) for their child and can provide support to other families in similar situations. The FSP promotes engagement, support, and connection of families to natural and community supports.
<b><i>Natural Supports</i></b>	People that the family identifies as supportive in their life (friends, extended family, faith-based organizations, mentoring, tutoring, interest groups, etc.). The team identifies, engages, and involves supports in the HFW process. These relationships are developed and fostered over time.
<b><i>Systems</i></b>	HFW focuses on youth with behavioral health and mental/emotional healthcare needs and their families who are involved with multiple child-serving agencies (social services, juvenile court, schools, behavioral health, physical health, etc.).
<b><i>Wraparound Coach</i></b>	The Supervisor of the Wraparound team that assures fidelity to the model
<b><i>Wraparound Facilitator (WF)</i></b>	The individual who provides concentrated care coordination that facilitates support to the family in developing their unique vision.
<b><i>Youth Support Partner (YSP)</i></b>	Supports young people who transition, who are involved in a child-serving system (e.g. foster care, mental health) or experiencing a unique challenge. The YSP uses their own lived experiences with mental health or other child serving system to relate and engage with the youth they serve. In their work together, the YSP helps the youth to identify goals and advocate for themselves.
